**Sub: Issuance of Radio Frequency Identification (RFID)Tag to  
Vehicles entering Docks.**

Mumbai Port Trust is in the process of automation of vehicle registration module. It has been decided to issue a one time, Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) Tag to all the Vehicles entering the docks. The Drivers & the Cleaners of these vehicles should be enrolled in Access Control System. In this regard, circulars dated 11.03.2017 and 31.03.2017 have been issued for issuance of RFID tag to the vehicles on the basis of original/ copy of R.C Book of the vehicles and enrolment of driver and cleaner of the vehicle in the system on the basis of original / photocopy of Aadhar card and driving licence of the driver and original / photocopy of Aadhar card of cleaner.

2. The RFID Tags which were being issued at VDS Chowkey near 7 Warehouse PD are now being issued from Yellow Gate Princess Dock. Further, in order to facilitate the trade, a pre-check point has now been created with effect from 02.10.2017 at "J plot Grain Depot", Opp. Ujala Hotel, near 'E' Shed, Grain Depot, where following activities are being carried out in all the three shifts :-

- (i) Vehicle Registration in the system
- (ii) Issuance of RFID Tag
- (iii) Registration of Driver and Cleaner
- (iv) Issuance of daily vehicle permit
- (v) Linking Driver / Cleaner with vehicle

3. It is, therefore, requested that all the transporters and their employees who are required to be registered be made aware of the new system and wide publicity is given to this registration system.

4. All are requested to register their vehicles, drivers and cleaners, at the earliest date as from 01.11.2017, no vehicle without RFID tag will be permitted inside the docks.
