**Sub: Issuance of Radio Frequency Identification (RFID)Tag to
Vehicles entering Docks.**

Ref: TM/HI (Access Control) /3003/2016-17 dt 11.03.2017.

Mumbai Port Trust is in the process of automation of vehicle registration module for which contract has been awarded to M/s Wipro Ltd. It has been decided to issue one time, Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) Tag to all the Vehicles entering docks w. e. f. 14th March, 2017. In this regards, circular dated 11.03.2017 has already been issued for issuance of RFID tag to the vehicles on the basis of original R.C Book of the vehicles. As it is observed that the original R.C. Book is not many times readily available in the vehicle, in partial modification to the circular under reference, it is now decided that, registration of vehicles and issuance of RFID tag can be carried out on production of photocopy of R.C. book. Similarly, for enrolment of driver and cleaner of the vehicle in the system, instead of original, photocopy of Aadhar card and driving licence of the driver and photocopy of Aadhar card of cleaner can be produced and the same will be returned after scanning. All other conditions will remain the same as per the earlier circular.

All are requested to register their vehicles at the earliest date as from 15.04.2017 no vehicle without RFID tag will be permitted inside the docks.
