to be observed while handling of cargo
(containers etc.) on Barge (s) – reg.**

Asstt. Director (Safety), Inspectorate Dock Safety, Mumbai has observed that the activity of handling of cargo (containers etc.) on barge (s) is increased in Mumbai Port. During the course of inspection / visit of Mumbai Port it is observed by him that the cargo (container etc.) handling activity carried out on the barge(s) is unsafe / haphazard manner which is having the potential to cause the accident(s) to the Dock Worker(s).

Asstt. Director (Safety) has advised to ensure that the cargo (containers etc.) handling activity is carried out on the Barge(s) safely and strictly under the close / effective supervision in order to protect the safety of the Dock Worker(s) at the Port of Mumbai.

In view of the above, you are directed to strictly comply with the above advice of Asstt. Director, Safety, Inspectorate Dock Safety, Mumbai.
