Record Heavy-Lift Unit Handled by MbPT

Made in India L&T Boiler manufactured in HE- Hazira Gross Weight 809 Tonnes and Auxiliary Boiler 93 Tonnes arrived in Mumbai Port Indira Dock and loaded on heavy lift ship PALEISGRACHT docked at Berth No. 3/4 Ship through barge AF-250 transit cargo for Balongan Indonesia. Entire operation was carried out on 10th December 2021 by Port Dock Tugs & in the guidance of Pilots & Dock Master".

Mumbai Port handles Chemical Tanker for Benefit of Trade

Tanker spot market prices are sky rocketing hence the need for smaller tanker for small parcel sizes is requisite to save foreign exchange. Also it is cost cutting for importer and exporter.

MbPT under the leadership of Shri Rajiv Jalota, IAS, Chairman and Shri Adesh Titarmare, IAS, Dy. Chairman, handled a small tanker MT Aqua Marine LOA 85 meters. Vessel was scheduled to load 2300 MT of Ethyl Acetate, the High value cargo can only be loaded directly from terminal through pipelines. Tanker was berthed with one tanker barge alongside berth to comply with requirement/ avoid damage to jetty fenders.

Planning and execution of operation was done by Marine department successfully under guidance of Capt. B. Chand (Dy. Conservator) on 14th Nov'21. Vessel was safely berthed at FCB (NPP) completed cargo operation and sailed on 15th Nov'21. Henceforth, MbPT can handle the small tankers for loading and discharging of chemicals with special

arrangement and precautions.

The Mumbai Liquid Cargo Importer and Exporter Association and Shipping Agents have appreciated the efforts of MbPT which are benefiting EXIM trade.



Traffic Handled During Dec'21

At MbPT Traffic handled during Dec-21 was 5.48 million tonnes as against 4.75 million tonnes handled in Dec-20 showing increase of 15.31% and Cumulative Traffic April to Dec-21 was 44.32 million tonnes as against 38.03 million tonnes handled during corresponding period of previous year showing increase of 16.53%

Client Friendly Steps taken by MbPT

(i) Pursuant to the meeting with Automobile Trade held on 16.11.2021, a steering committee headed by Shri R. N. Shaikh is formed to liaise with various concerned authorities, monitors progress of issues on regular interval and ensure that issues are timely resolved. The 1st meeting of steering committee was held on 30.12.2021 where representative from CE, DC, FA&CAO, TM and CISF were present. The short term issues were discussed and decisions taken in consultation with concerned departments. The issues are resolved.

(ii) It was decided to follow up with proposal for oil tank in Indira Dock pursuant to the request of trade. An area of about 2000 sq.m. for actual Importer / Exporter to be offered initially for 5 terms of 11 months each. The SOR rate to be charged as a basic reserve price. This is based on Land Lease Model. Base price will be fixed and the bidder is expected to quote premium over the above reserve (base) price at which rentals shall be paid. Dy. Traffic Manager, CA is dealing with the proposal.

Sugar Movement

During December, 90549 tonnes of Sugar was brought by MbPT Railway of which 47821 tonnes was loaded on the ships.

Major Targets for Jan - 2022 and 2021-22

Traffic target (Pro-rata) for Jan-2022 is 4.7 million tonnes and the same for 2021-22 is 56.00 million tonnes.
