**Minutes of the Dry Dock Allotment Planning Meeting  
held on 27/03/2014**

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The Dry Dock Allotment Planning meeting was held with the Users of Dry Dock at 3.00 p.m. on 27.03.2014 in CME's office (Nirman Bhavan). Representatives of 29 user firms were present in the meeting. Dy. CME, Shri A.B. Udavant, presided over the meeting while Shri V.V. Prabhu, Dy. CME was also present.

2. At the outset, Shri Udavant welcomed all the Dry Dock users present and informed that as usual applications of only those Dry Dock users who are present in today's meeting shall be considered for allotment.

3. Shri Udavant informed that as per guidelines, MbPT vessels and Lock Gate, Naval vessels and vessels of Government agencies are considered on priority. Similarly, for those vessels references received to consider them on priority with certificates will also be considered on priority.

4. Applications/requests received from users for interchange of their vessels have been considered and accordingly allotments have been made as per their requests.

5. Some of the user representatives informed that their vessels may be deleted from the list and hence such vessels have been deleted from the list.

6. As discussed in the meeting on 12-12-2013 and minuted, the names of vessels for which applications were made during the year 2011 have been deleted from the list of Dry docking applications. Those names which have been deleted inadvertently shall be retained. Such users can submit their request in writing within one week's time.

7. A copy of the list of Dry Dock applications was furnished to all representatives present in the meeting. A tentative Dry Docking programme for HDD has been drawn scheduled from 16. 04.2014 to 16.09.2014. The schedule of tentative programme of Dry Docking as discussed and agreed by the representatives present in the meeting is enclosed. MbPT reserves the right to make changes considering the deserving cases of emergency and the vessels whose name is remained to be added in the list inadvertently.

8. Next Dry Dock allotment meeting will probably be scheduled in September 2014 or earlier. Users were requested to keep in touch.
