Minutes of the Dry Dock Allotment Planning Meeting
Convened by DY.CME held on 07.08.2012

The Open Public Dry Dock Allotment Planning meeting was held at 3.00 p.m. on 07.08.2012. Representatives of 30 user firms were present at the meeting.

2. At the outset, the Dy.CME welcomed all the Dry Dock users and reiterated that the allotment for the Dry dock is being, as a practice, done on 1st come 1st serve basis and deserving cases of priority. The extant practice of registration list of 12 months is being followed.

3. DY.CME informed that the present list is more than 3 years old and as decided in the last meeting held on 24.4.2012, names of users/vessels who had applied/registered for Dry Dock slot upto 2009 were deleted from the list dated 18th April 2012 except those who confirmed their requirement prior to the meeting. If they desire to maintain their request for allotment, they are required to confirm the registration with a letter stating the correct date and time when they require the Dry Dock slot.

4. DY.CME informed that those who have arrears of payment will not be considered for Dry Dock allotment and users who are listed in the payment pending will have to bring 'No dues certificate' before granting Dry Docking permission/allotment. The names of payment defaulters were read out for information of the users. The payment defaulters were requested to make payment at the earliest and in any case before their allotment is considered.

5. Dy. CME informed that emergency allotments are done on priority which are done strictly on the basis of recommendations of the D.G. Shipping or Indian Register of Shipping or other International Classification Society's Surveyor's only and the users are required to submit documents certified by the Surveyors stating the reasons for emergency and clear-cut recommendations by the Surveyor for emergency Dry docking. DY.CME requested all DD Users to adhere to the schedule as per allotment made.

6. The Dy.CME explained that vessels accommodated in the same compartment shall have same period of stay which shall be agreed to by the Dry dock users while giving the allotment although their requirement may slightly vary.

7. Dy. CME informed all Dry Dock users to inform MbPT well in advance if inter-change of their vessels is desired. Statement showing the status of the pending applications for allotment of Dry dock was read out to all the firms' representatives who were present at the meeting. A copy of the statement was furnished to all representatives who were present.

8. Considering all the above issues, a tentative Dry docking programme for HDD has been scheduled from 21st August, 2012 upto 19th November, 2012.

9. A Schedule of Tentative Programme of Dry Docking as discussed in the meeting is enclosed. MbPT reserves the right to make changes considering the deserving cases of emergency.

10. Next Dry Dock Allotment Meeting is scheduled in third week of October, 2012.
