**Sub: Storage facilities for imported
Agri products.**

Ref: This office circular No.TM/D/4-3/43
of 1996-97 dated 28.7.2011.

In continuation to this office circular referred to hereinabove, this is to inform that it has been decided to extend facilities for long term storage of bagged cargo of Imported Agri products in notified areas upto a maximum period of 180 days, on recovery of charges as detailed below:

Location	Period of storage	Rate per sq.mtr. or part thereof, per month or part thereof. (In Rs.)
Sheds	First 30 days or part thereof	40.00
	31 st day to 180 th day	80.00
Open Yards	First 30 days or part thereof	30.00
	31 st day to 180 th day	60.00

2. It may be noted that -

- i) In the event of non-clearance of consignments within the period of 180 days, demurrage shall be recovered from 181st day onwards at the rates specified in Section 3.1(B) of Chapter III of Scale of Rates.
- ii) The charges will be subjected to revision of section 3.3 (A) (II) of the Scale of Rates.
- iii) The above scheme will remain valid for a period of one year from 01.8.2012 and reviewed thereafter.

3. You are requested to give wide publicity amongst your members to avail of the facility.
