**Sub: Concessional rates for demurrage on
export of agricultural products.**

The Tariff Authority for Major Ports (TAMP) has approved and notified revised Scale of Rates on 22.11.2011, to be effective from 22.12.2012.

2. Vide circular No.TM/D/4-3/35 of 96-97 dated 11.04.2011, concessional rates for demurrage on export of agricultural products were extended upto 26.04.2012.

3. In this regard, the Board has accorded sanction to continue the facility of concessional rate for recovery of demurrage on export of agricultural products for a further period of one year from 27.04.2012 with revised concessional rates as under :

- i) Rs.13/- per ton per day from 1st to 20th day as against Rs.48.75 per ton per day;
- ii) Rs.33/- per ton per day from 21st to 40th day as against Rs.73.10 per ton per day; and
- iii) Rs.78/- per ton per day from 41st day onwards as against Rs.97.50 per ton per day.

4. The above rates will be effective from 27.04.2012 for one year. The differential amount between the rates as per revised **Scale of Rate and the concessional rates** will be treated as remitted.

5. All exporters of agricultural commodities and their Associations are requested to avail this facility and route their exports of agri-products through Mumbai Port.

6. You are requested to give wide publicity amongst all your members to avail the benefits of the aforesaid concession.
