**Sub : Storage of cargo in Non Custom notified
areas – Recovery of storage charges.**

Vide Circular Nos.TM/A/15-22/24 of 1995-96 dated 31.01.08, TM/A/15-22/34 of 95-96 dated 18.02.09, TM/A/15-22/29 of 95-96 dated 11.12.08, TM/A/15-22/25 of 95-96 dated 22.02.08 and TM/A/15-22/3 of 95-96 dated 13.05.08 A,K,L,N, T, G, Shed Grain Depot, H Comptt. Cotton Avenue and FCI Godown, WINC were specified/notified for storage of cargo on recovery of licence (storage) fees in terms of Section 3.3(A)(II) of the Scale of Rates.

2. The Board in its meeting held on 17.03.2012 has reviewed the matter and decided that with effect from 22.12.2011 the storage areas which are not listed under Appendix 'G' of the Dock Bye-Laws and earmarked earlier for storage of import pulses, etc. imported through Mumbai Port will be charged tariff under General Bye-Laws for storage of cargo and storage will be permitted for a maximum period of 180 days.

3. Accordingly, the storage areas viz. A,K,L,N,T,G, sheds Grain Depot, H Comptt. Cotton Avenue and FCI Godown, WINC will be permitted to be used for storage of cargo cleared from Docks, under General Bye-Laws and the following tariff will be leviable with effect from 22.12.2011.

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1	Rs.1.5/-	Rs.2.0
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4. The maximum period of storage will be upto 180 days from the date of storage. In respect of the cargoes which have already been permitted storage on or after 22.12.2011, the period of 180 days will be counted from 22.12.2011 or the date of initial storage, whichever is earlier.

5. If the cargo is not cleared within 180 days from the date of initial storage, charges @Rs.6.00/- per sq.mtr. per day will be leviable from 181st day onwards.

6. You are requested to give wide publicity amongst your members to avail of the facility.
