TRADE NOTICE

Please refer to the DGFT Notification No.06/2025-26 dated 02.05.2025 and CBIC circular No.F No.:401/17/2025-CUS.III dt. 03.05.2025. The directives from the Government are imposed with effect from the date of above orders. Hence any vessel carrying aforesaid mentioned cargo on board will not be permitted.

It is clarified that as per the Central Government decision, Mumbai Port Authority shall not permit any vessel to berth, carrying goods originating in or exported from Pakistan.

Also, please refer DGS order No.05 of 2025. As per the Order, a Ship bearing the flag of Pakistan will not be allowed to visit Mumbai Port. The directives shall come in force with immediate effect and remain in force till further orders.

Subject: Prohibition on Import or transit of all goods originating in or exported from Pakistan- Insertion of Para 2.20A of Foreign Trade Policy (FTP) 2023, - reg.

S.O. (E) In exercise of powers conferred by Section 3 read with Section 5 of Foreign Trade (Development & Regulation) Act, 1992, read with paragraph 1.02 and 2.01 of the Foreign Trade Policy (FTP) 2023, as amended from time to time, the Central Government hereby inserts a new Para 2.20A in Foreign Trade Policy, 2023 as follows with immediate effect:

"Para 2.20A: Prohibition on Import from Pakistan
Direct or indirect Import or transit of all goods originating in or exported from Pakistan, whether or not freely importable or otherwise permitted, shall be prohibited with immediate effect, until further orders. This restriction is imposed in the interest of national security and public policy. Any exception to this prohibition shall require prior approval of the Government of India."

Effect of the Notification: Para 2.20A of FTP, 2023 is inserted to prohibit direct or indirect import or transit of all goods originating in or exported from Pakistan with immediate effects until further orders.

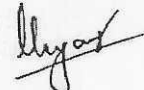

DGS ORDER NO. 05 OF 2025

UNDER SECTION 411 (READ WITH PREAMBLE) OF MERCHANT SHIPPING ACT, 1958

Whereas, the preamble of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1958 enshrines the objectives of the Act.

2. Whereas, the objective of Act, is to foster the development and ensure the efficient maintenance of an Indian mercantile marine, in a manner best suited to serve the national interests.
3. Whereas the said Act deal with Indian flag ships wherever these may be and Foreign Flag ships while in Indian waters, to ensure safety of life at sea and safety of ships.
4. Whereas section 411 empowers the Director General of Shipping, Govt of India, to issue directions to ships, for meeting the objective of national interest or the interest of Indian shipping.
5. Now, therefore, in exercise of power conferred by section 411 of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1958 read with objectives as enshrined under Preamble of the said Act, keeping in view of the present situation, the following directions are hereby issued:
 - 5.1. A ship bearing the flag of Pakistan shall not be allowed to visit any Indian Port.
 - 5.2. An Indian flag ship shall not visit any Ports of Pakistan.
6. This order is issued to ensure safety of Indian assets, cargo and connected infrastructure, in public interest and for interest of Indian shipping.
7. Any exemption or dispensation from this order shall be examined and decided on case-to-case basis.
8. This order shall come into force with immediate effect and remain in force till further order.
