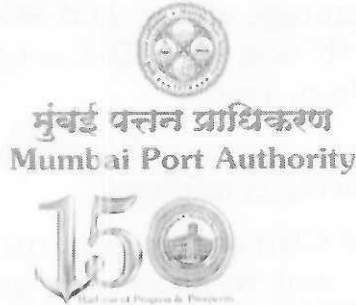

Sub : Nomination of an open area of 10,000 sq.mtr.
at MOD-3 North Side for storage all cargoes under
Section 3.3(A)(II) of Chapter III of Scale of Rates.

Through various Trade Circulars, sheds/areas have been nominated in Docks and Outlying areas for storage of Import cargoes under provisions of Section 3.3 (A) (II) / (V) of Chapter III of Scale of Rates (SOR), in order to attract more cargo and in view of demand from MbPA Port Users.

2. Due to the demand from trade regarding the open storage facility for Iron and Steel, vide Circular No.TM/D/4-3/48 dated 24.02.2025, the open area at North Side of MOD-3 Shed was nominated for storage of Iron and Steel cargo, subject to completion of Customs and MbPA formalities viz. payment of Port charges for the area and Customs Out of Charge for clearance of cargo, upto 60 days as per the provisions of Section 3.3 (A) (II)/(V) of Chapter III of SOR and demurrage charges as per Section 3.1 (B) of SOR will also be applicable at the above location for storage from 61st day and onwards vide Circular dated 24.02.2025.

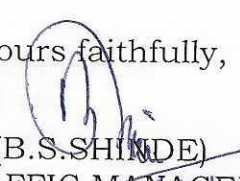
3. In addition to the storage of Iron and Steel, the above mentioned area of 10,000 sq.mtrs. at North side of MOD-3 is nominated for other cargoes as well, as per the demand from Trade.

4. Storage permission of cargoes at the subject area will be granted subject to compliance of the following conditions:-

- a) The Importer/ CHB shall obtain the Out of Charge from Customs for the cargo and transport the same to the licensed area, on completion of Port and Customs formalities.
- b) The cargo shall be removed by the Importer/CHB at their own risk, responsibility and cost to the area permitted for storage of cargo.
- c) The storage of cargo at the permitted site shall be solely at the risk, cost and responsibility of the importer/CHB.
- d) The Importer/CHB shall be required to vacate the permitted site as and when required by the Port for which 15 days notice will be issued to the importer/CHB.
- e) In case of any requirement of the permitted area by MbPA, the Importer/ CHB shall shift the cargo to any other location within 15 days as indicated by the Port, for which the shifting charges shall be borne by the Importer/CHB.
- f) The permission shall be initially for a period of one month and in case of further extension for permission of the storage area, the Importer/CHB should make an application and obtain permission from this office at least 7 days prior to completion of the 30th day.
- g) The area actually occupied by the cargo shall be measured by the Shed Supdt. and will be certified for recovery of license fees.
- h) All possible care and safety precautions shall be taken by the Importer/CHB during the transportation of cargo so that there is no nuisance or disturbance in other operations as well as the local environment and public health.

5. It is requested to give wide publicity amongst your members to avail the above facility.
