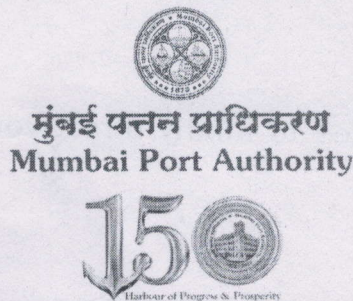

Sub : Facility of berthing of vessels carrying fertilizer and
fertilizer raw materials like Ammonium Sulphate,
MOP, MAP, DAP, etc at BPX / BPS.

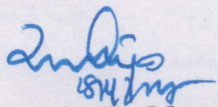
By Circular No. TM/A/15-33/06 dated 10.06.2020, trade was informed that import vessels with a draft of more than 8.5 meters carrying Fertilizer and Fertilizer Raw Materials such as Ammonium Sulphate, MOP, MAP, DAP, etc. will be initially berthed at BPS/BPX and, on reducing the draft, shifted to another berth in Indira Dock for continuing the discharge operations.

2. It is to inform that Mumbai International Cruise Terminal (MICT) has been commissioned w.e.f. 06.03.2025.

3. Considering the glass facade and open portion of the MICT building facing BPX berth and the possibility of dust or particles spreading into the terminal building, it has been decided to discontinue handling of vessels carrying Fertilizer and Fertilizer Raw Material such as Ammonium Sulphate, MOP, MAP, DAP, etc. at BPX berth.

It has also been decided to continue to handle such vessels at BPS berth. Vessel Agents/Handling Agents/Receivers are required to exercise due diligence during the cargo operations to prevent spillage and spreading of dust / particles in air. Vessels will be berthed at BPS berth towards maximum possible North side.

4. You are requested to kindly direct your members to take note of the same.
