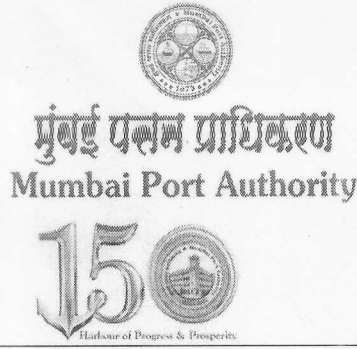

Sub : Nomination of 6000 sq.mtr. at North end
of RCD (Rail Container Depot) Yard, Cotton Green
for storage of Export Vehicles
under Section 3.3(A)(II) of Chapter III
of Scale of Rates.

Through various Trade Circulars, sheds/open areas have been nominated within Docks and at Outlying areas for storage of cargo under provisions of Section 3.3 (A) (II) of Chapter III of Scale of Rates (SOR), in view of demand from MbPA Port Users.

2. Due to the increasing demand from the trade regarding the storage facility for export vehicles, area measuring approx. 6000 sq.mtr. at north end of RCD Yard is nominated for storage of Export Vehicles, subject to completion of required MbPA formalities viz. payment of Port charges under the provisions of Section 3.3(A)(II) of Chapter III of Scale of Rates, etc.

3. Storage permission would be granted subject to compliance of the following conditions:-

- a) The Export Vehicles shall be removed by the Exporter/CHB at their own risk, responsibility and cost from RCD to the permitted area.
- b) The storage of Export Vehicles at the RCD shall be solely at the risk, cost and responsibility of the Exporter/CHB.
- c) In case of any requirement of the permitted area by MbPA, the Exporter/CHB shall shift the Export Vehicles to any other location, as indicated by the Port, for which 15 days notice will be issued to the Exporter/CHB and the shifting charges for the same shall be borne by the Exporter/CHB.
- d) All possible care and safety precautions shall be taken by the Exporter/CHB during the transportation of Export Vehicles, so that there is no nuisance or disturbance in other operations, as well as the local environment and public health.

4. It is requested to give wide publicity amongst your members to avail the above facility.
