CIRCULAR

Applications are invited for registration to the course of **DIPLOMATE OF NATIONAL BOARD IN THE FACULTIES OF GENERAL MEDICINE * & OBSTETRICS & GYNAECOLOGY *** from the candidates who fulfil the following criteria:-

- 1) Candidates should have passed M.B.B.S. from any recognized University and have completed internship on or before 30.06.2010.
- 2) Candidates should have registration from Maharashtra Medical Council.
- 3) Candidates should have passing certificate of the DNB-CET Examination
- 4) In case of post diploma seat in the faculty of Obstetrics & Gynaecology, the diploma course should be recognised by the Medical Council of India. (irrespective of their having passed the primary Examinations and having completed one year of house-job/special training before joining the diploma course)

*** Our accreditation with the National Board of Examinations, New Delhi for the faculties of Medicine and Obstetrics & Gynaecology will expire in the month of June 2010. We have already applied for renewal of accreditation. Therefore, registration in these faculties is subject to continuation of accreditation by NBE. Candidates selected in these faculties will have to give undertaking that he/she will accept terms and conditions related to this.**

The selected candidate will have to undergo medical check-up. He/she will have to pay refundable security deposit of Rs.5000/- at the time of accepting the post. If any candidate leaves the post before completion of tenure or his/her services are terminated due to unsatisfactory work performance, the office shall inform the National Board of Examinations, New Delhi to cancel the Registration of the said candidate. The deposit amount paid in such cases will be forfeited.

The selected candidate will have to complete the formalities of Mumbai Port Trust and get himself/herself registered with National Board of Examination, New Delhi in the allotted subject. He/she will have to do the Residential Medical Officer's post in the Mumbai Port Trust Hospital, Wadala, Mumbai for a period of 36 months in case of those who have passed CET-NBE or 24 months in case of those who have passed **DGO** examination recognized by Medical Council of India. These posts are residential posts and therefore candidates will have to be available for attending the duties for 24 hours except on the days when he/she is not on duty. Whenever they are on call, they can leave campus only for any urgent/emergency work with the prior permission of their faculty in-charge.

The post commences from **02.08.2010** and the work performance will be reviewed every six months. The post carries stipend of Rs. 15771/- p.m. with increase of Rs. 231/- every year for the candidates undergoing course of three years and those who have diploma qualification will get a stipend of Rs.16,002/- p.m. with increase of Rs.231/- every year. Candidate will be required to pay fees of Rs. 50,000/- per year as prescribed by National Board of Examinations.

Candidates should apply in the prescribed form, which can be obtained from the Accounts Cell, Mumbai Port Trust Hospital, 1st floor, on payment of Rs 200/- from **21.06.2010 to 03.07.2010 from 10.30 am to 1.00 pm and 2.00 pm to 5.00 pm.** The said form should be submitted duly filled in along with the attested xerox copies of the required documents to the Chief Medical Officer's Office not later than 03.07.2010 upto 5.00 p.m. Any incomplete application form, and forms received after 5.00 p.m. on 03.07.2010 shall not be considered. There will not be any communication from Mumbai Port Trust Hospital. The selection of the candidate shall be as per the notified rules of National Board of Examinations, New Delhi.

The interviews will be held as per the attached schedule. All the original certificates should be produced for verification at the time of interview. The candidates are also directed to refer to the Notice Board for the schedule for detailed activities and dates and also other notices in connection with the course from time to time. The waiting lists prepared at the time of interview will be valid up to the dates mentioned on the said lists.
