Sub : Storage of export cargo in Non Custom notified areas – Recovery of storage charges.

Ref : (i) This office circular No.TM/D/4-3/66 dtd.22.03.2012. (ii) This office circular No. TM/D/4-3/01 dtd. 10.04.2012.

Vide Circulars dated 22.03.12 and 10.04.12, A,K,L,N, T, G, Shed Grain Depot, H Comptt. Cotton Avenue and FCI Godown, WINC were specified/notified for storage of cargo cleared from the docks under General Bye-Laws with effect from 22.12.11.

2. Recently, there has been demand from the Trade for storage of export agri cargo in the outlying Dock areas. It is informed that A,K,L,N,T sheds are earmarked for storage of export agri products on recovery of charges as prescribed in the circular dated 22.03.12 with maximum period of 60 days; whereafter the storage will be treated as unauthorized and penal charges @Rs.20/- per sq.mtr. per day will be levied from the 61st day onwards.
