Sub: Pre Arrival Notification of Security (PANS) for vessels calling Mumbai Port.

Subsequent to this office Circular Nos.DC/C-SH/2105 & 2439 dated 13.05.2013 & 06.06.2013 respectively regarding Pre Arrival Notification of Security (PANS) by merchant ships entering Indian Ports.

- 2. It is now required that advance arrival information (PANS) for Port of Mumbai is required 96 hours in advance of schedule time of arrival of a vessel as per ISPS plan.
- 3. If the voyage is of less than 96 hours, then this information shall be submitted within 2 hours of departure from the last port. This also applies to vessels trading in coastal water or coasting between Indian Ports.
