LEVY OF CHARGES ON CONTAINERISED CARGO BROUGHT FROM INDIAN PORT BY ROAD TO MUMBAI PORT.

Sub: Levy of charges on containerised cargo brought

from Indian Port by road to Mumbai Port.

In continuation to this office circular No. C/3-93/TM/Circular/6 of 1988-89 dated 23.06.2006, the free days/charges to be levied on the container and containerised cargo brought from other Indian Ports to Mumbai Port by road is extended for a further period of one year with effect from 01.07.2007. The free days/ charges will be as under:

<u>I</u>) <u>Containers Destuffed in the Port:</u>

(i) <u>Container:</u>

Three free days from the date of receipt of the container; licence (storage) fee from the fourth day.

(ii) <u>Containerised Cargo:</u>

Five free days from the date of receipt of container and demurrage from the sixth day.

II) Containers Not Destuffed in the Port and Removed Out of the Port:

(i) <u>Container</u>:

No free day and license (storage) fees will be levied from the day of receipt of container.

(ii) <u>Containerised Cargo:</u>

Three free days from the date of receipt of container and demurrage from the fourth day.

The above free days/levy of charges on container and containerised cargo shall be applicable for a period of one year from 01.07.2007.
