# CREATION OF ZONES IN THE DOCKS AND ISSUANCE OF ONE DAY PERMIT, ZONEWISE

Sub: Creation of Zones in the Docks and issuance

of one day permit, zone wise.

Presently, one day Dock Entry Permits are issued from the Permit Section and Blue Gate ID for the workers/employees of the various Port Users, contract workers, etc. for carrying out their specific activities in the Docks i.e. Indira Dock, Victoria Dock and Princes Dock. The area of work for one-day permit is normally indicated as ID/VD/PD.

2. In view of the heightened security in and around the Docks and the recommendations received from the Intelligence Bureau, the Docks area shall be divided into different Zones as under **with effect from 1**<sup>st</sup> **July 2007.** 

ZONES IN DOCKS AREA	
I	Prince's Dock
II	Mereweather Dry Dock PD
III	Victoria Dock
IV	Indira Dock
V	Hughes Dry Dock ID

VI	BPX/BPS
ZONES IN OUTLYING AREAS	
VII	CFS/Frere Basin/MOD/STP
VIII	Hay Bunder
IX	Haji Bunder

- 3. The purpose of creating zone in the Docks is to ensure that the Port Users entering with specific works for civil works, ship repairing, etc. restrict themselves to the Zone for which the permits have been issued and not loiter in areas other than specified in the Dock permit. This will also help in monitoring the movement of employees/ workers of the Port users within a specific zone in particular.
- 4. All the Port Users, therefore, are requested to ensure that while submitting application for issuance of one-day permit the location to be visited is indicated with corresponding Zone no. in the application. For e.g.

# To visit 12B ID indicate Zone IV (12B ID)

## To visit 2 V.D. indicate Zone III (2 V.D.)

After the application is processed and verified, one day permit will be issued from the Permit Section or Blue Gate ID, specifying the Zone no. on the permit. Employees/workers of the Port users, if found in zones, other than the one indicated in the permit a fine of Rs. 500/- shall be recovered and their permits will be confiscated and registration of the Company shall be liable to be blacklisted and suspended.

5. You are requested to give wide publicity to all members on the creation of Zones in the Docks and direct your members to strictly abide by the instructions detailed above.
