Sub: Nomination of areas for storage of import pulses under Section 3.3 (A)(II) of Chapter III of Scale of Rates.

Vide various circulars issued in the past, certain storage areas were nominated in the outlying Dock areas for storage of import cargo on recovery of license (storage) fees, under the provisions of Section 3.3 (A)(II) of Scale of Rates.

- 2. Due to increase in demand for storage of pulses, imported through Mumbai Port, it has been decided to nominate the following areas for storage of pulses cleared from Docks, under the provisions of Section 3.3 (A)(II) of Scale of Rates, for one year:
 - (i) 'C' Shed Haji Bunder
 - (ii) Temporary shed at Wadala Incinerator plot

The storage will be permitted on monthly basis on the request of Importers/CHAs on 'first come first served basis'.
