Sub: Concessional rates for demurrage on

export of agricultural products.

Ref: Circular No. TM/D/4-3/02 of 12-13 dated 10.04.2012

Vide circular dated 10.04.2012 referred to above, concessional rates for demurrage on export of agricultural products were extended upto 26.04.2013. The Board has now accorded sanction to reintroduce the facility of concessional rates for recovery of demurrage on export of agricultural products as under:

- Rs.13/- per ton per day from 1<sup>st</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> day as against Rs.48.75 per ton i) per day;
- Rs.33/- per ton per day from 21st to 40th day as against Rs.73.10 per ii) ton per day; and
- Rs.78/- per ton per day from 41<sup>st</sup> day onwards as against Rs.97.50 per iii) ton per day.
- 2. The above concessional rates will be effective from 08.03.2014 for one year, subject to review after notification of revised SOR by TAMP. The differential amount between the rates as per Scale of Rate and the concessional rates will be treated as remitted.

- 3. All exporters of agricultural commodities and their Associations are requested to avail this facility and route their exports of agri-products through Mumbai Port.
- 4. You are requested to give wide publicity amongst all your members to avail the benefits of the aforesaid concession.
