Sub: Storage of import pulses at STP Shed No.3 under Section 3.3 (A)(II) of Chapter III Scale of Rates.

Vide Circular No.TM/D/4-3/29 of 1996-97 dated 09.11.2012, STP-3 Shed was notified for storage of import bagged cargo under Section 3.3 (A)(II) of Chapter III of Scale of Rates, till 30.04.2013.

- 2. Due to increase in pulses traffic and demand from the trade, STP-3 Shed is being re-notified for storage of import pulses cleared from the Docks under Section 3.3 (A)(II) of Chapter III of Scale of Rates with the following conditions:
 - (i) As a precautionary measure, the Importer/ CHA will have to leave approximately 2.0 mtrs, on periphery of all sides of the shed and the cargo will have to be stored in the central position.
 - (ii) The storage will be permitted at the risk and cost of the Importer/ CHA and they will have to protect their cargo stored in STP-3 shed in all seasons, particularly during monsoon.
 - (iii) Under no circumstances, MbPT will be held responsible for damage of any cargo stored thereat.
- 3. You are requested to give wide publicity amongst your members to avail of the facility.
