Sub: Nomination of area for storage of import pulses under Section 3.3 (A)(II) of Chapter III of Scale of Rates.

Vide Circular No.TM/A/15-22/25 of 2010-11 dated 23.12.2010, area admeasuring 1600 sq. mtrs. each at MOD-2 and MOD-4 alongwith open areas at other locations in the outlying areas of Docks were notified/specified for storage of import cargo. Further, vide Circular No. TM/A/15-22/65 of 95-96 dated 22.03.2012, MOD Shed No.2 and Frere Basin Shed No.2 were notified/specified for storage of export cargo on recovery of license (storage) fees, under the provisions of Section 3.3 (A)(II) of Scale of Rates.

- 2. Due to increase in demand for storage of pulses, imported through Mumbai Port, it has been decided to notify/specify the entire MOD Shed No.2 and MOD Shed No. 4, for storage of import pulses with immediate effect, under the provisions of Section 3.3 (A)(II) of Scale of Rates .
