ii) An applicant or appellant repeating the RTI application or appeal either once or multiple times, suppressing the fact of earlier application and receipt of the answer, the CPIO of public authority may reject it forthwith after intimating it along with reasons.

Regarding points A, B, C, D, E & F, it is to be stated that as per the guidelines for Public Authorities under RTI Act, 2005, it is not required to create information or to interpret information or to solve the problems raised by the applicants or to furnish replies to the hypothetical questions.
